**Wejdan Jaber** is a Muslim Palestinian, awarded a USAID "Clinton Scholarship" in 2000, and a Master's in Public Administration and International Management from the Monterey Institute for International Studies, Monterey, California, in 2002. Born in Gaza, she currently lives in the West Bank city of Ramallah.

**Abir Kopty** is a Christian Palestinian citizen of Israel. She was nominated as one of twelve "People of the Year" in Israel in 2005. She served as Media Coordinator and Spokeswoman for Mossawa, the Advocacy Center for Arab Citizens in Israel, Haifa.



**Hagit Ra'an** is a Jewish Israeli who founded Bridges of Peace, and is a member of the Bereaved Families Forum., Ms. Ra'an's husband was killed in combat near Beirut during the first week of the war in Lebanon in 1982.
